- The best and brightest students still compete for admission to AUB. We are correctly
 viewed by students, their families, media, and employers as the very finest liberal arts

 world. Our faculty have achieved a research output more than twice that of all other
 Lebanese universities combined. And AUB's research productivity, measured per dollar,

- Our worldwide alumni continue to achieve success in myriad professions and enthusiastically celebrate their affiliation with their alma mater. We have more alumni chapters (60) and deeper alumni involvement now than at any other time in our history.

For almost 150 years, we have made a difference to individual lives and communities across Lebanon and the Arab region. Even in the most difficult and challenging times, AUB continues to serve as a beacon of hope and a source of inspiration and opportunity.
