We are writing to remind you that Academic Advising for both summer 2022-23 and fall 2023-24 will start on Tuesday, April 4 through Thursday, April 6, 2023, and course registration will open for all current students for the summer term 2022-23 Tuesday, April 11 through Thursday, April 13, 2023.

Please prepare in advance for registration by selecting and noting the CRNs you wish to register. You may consult with your academic advisor(s) if you need help.

When you register, you must not have more than one registration session open or your session will crash.

Please also note that registering for courses for any purpose other than your own program completion is a violation of the student code of conduct and will be referred for disciplinary action.

Your registration and drop and add time tickets are generated as per the <u>Summer 2022-23 Registration Guide</u>. You may report any discrepancy in your time tickets to the <u>Registration Team</u>, and you may click <u>here</u> to access the system.

When you register, it is very important that you login using your **AUBnet** credentials (e.g., ab123 and email password). Your AUBsis credentials will not work.

If you are a student in your second semester, or a current special, freshman, transfer, majorless, or probationary student, you should seek academic advising since you be will be prompted to enter an alternate <u>PIN which must be provided by your academic advisor</u>. The purpose of the alternate PIN is to ensure that you and your advisor agree that you are on track in your curriculum and that you do not reach a point where you wish to graduate, but cannot because you are missing courses or credits.

If you are planning to register for the summer term 2022-23, please make sure you register for at least one course during the registration period (April 11 - 13, 2023).

Additionally, remember to include your AUB students ID # in all your inquiries.
