Dear students,

As a follow up to [today's message from President Khuri](#), I write with information about the measures we are putting in place to ensure the continuation of your education and safeguard your wellbeing. We will adapt and support you to ensure your educational journey progresses despite the fluid and challenging situation.

The following measures will be in place starting **Wednesday, March 4 through Tuesday, March 10**:

1. Classes will be transitioned to online delivery and will be held synchronously through available platforms. Your course instructors will reach out to you by email and via Moodle to share the links so you can connect during class time.
2. Your course instructors will make lecture materials (recordings, readings, resources, etc.) available asynchronously on Moodle. This ensures that students who are unable to attend live sessions due to, for example, emergency situations, family responsibilities, or lack of internet access, can still engage with the course content at their own pace.
3. Courses with significant experiential learning components that require physical presence (such as labs, studios, community engagements, etc.) will need to be postponed during this period, with plans to resume them as early as possible. Medical and nursing students should continue to follow the specific instructions provided by the Dean's Offices at the Faculty of Medicine and the Rafic Hariri School of Nursing.

4. There will be no tests or exams during this period (March 4-10). For course deliverables – including assignments, papers, and projects – your instructors are being encouraged to offer flexibility with deadlines.
5. The campus will be open for you to access libraries, workspaces, research labs, other facilities, and student support services within the faculties/schools and the Office of Student Affairs.
6. Please take the initiative to contact your academic advisor and course instructors for specific guidance regarding your courses and any personal circumstances that may require special academic arrangements.

We understand the significant challenges and disruptions you and your families are facing, and we are committed to providing the support you need during these trying times. We will also continue to provide you with updates on a regular basis.
