Dear AUB Students,

We are looking forward to the return to campus on October 1 and are thrilled to see so many of you around campus already.

Coming back to campus requires that we all take responsibility for ensuring the safety of the AUB community. For this reason, AUB launched a campaign to vaccinate all community members and is **requiring that students be vaccinated**. Access to campus for students will be controlled through their ID cards when they enter campus.

- If you are vaccinated (at least one dose), but have not provided proof to the Vaccination Working Group, you must send your documentation to <a href="mailto:vaxwg@aub.edu.lb">vaxwg@aub.edu.lb</a>.
- If you have had COVID after July 1, 2021, you must provide proof to the Vaccination Working Group by sending your positive PCR result to <a href="mailto:vaxwg@aub.edu.lb">vaxwg@aub.edu.lb</a>. After approximately twelve weeks from your positive PCR test date, you will be required to be vaccinated to continue to access campus.
- If you are not yet vaccinated, you must make arrangements to do so as soon as possible by following the instructions on the <u>AUBe Vaccinated website</u>.

In all three cases, you have until **Thursday, September 16** to provide documentation or arrange for your vaccination. **Barring compliance, your access to Moodle will be disabled on Monday, September 20**.

If you have serious medical reasons that you cannot be vaccinated, you must send a request to the Vaccination Working Group at <a href="mailto:vaxwg@aub.edu.lb">vaxwg@aub.edu.lb</a>, who will evaluate your file and give you a final judgment on your case.

If you have any questions or concerns, the AUB Vaccination Working Group will be holding a <u>virtual Q&A</u> <u>session</u> on Tuesday, September 14, 6-7 p.m.

Please attend to this matter as a priority. The health of the community and the success of our academic year depends on your collaboration.
