

## **Dr. Mohamed H. Sayegh selected for AST Award** Tuesday, March 30, 2010

The American Society of Transplantation (AST) has announced that its board of directors has selected Dr. Mohamed H. Sayegh as this year's recipient of the AST Basic Science Established Investigator Award (Professor Level). As the recipient of this award, he has been invited to attend an AST Awards Ceremony during the upcoming American Transplant Congress (ATC) in San Diego, CA. The ceremony will be held on Sunday, May 2, 2010.

Dr. Sayegh is AUB's vice president for Medical Affairs and the Raja N. Khuri dean of the Faculty of Medicine and the AUB Medical Center (AUBMC). He is a professor of medicine and pediatrics and holds the Warren E. Grupe and John P. Merrill Chair in Transplantation Medicine at Harvard Medical School. He is also the Director of the Schuster Family Transplantation Research Center at Brigham and Women's Hospital and Children's Hospital Boston.
