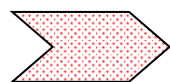

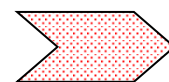

- ▶ Human organs, tissues, body parts...



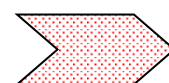
**Solid Biohazardous Waste**



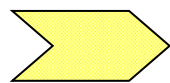
- Contaminated:**

  - ▶ Towels
  - ▶ Bench paper
  - ▶ Examination paper...



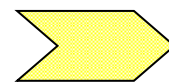
**Cytotoxic Drugs Sharps**



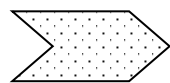
**Sharps contaminated with Chemotherapeutic & Cytotoxic drugs**  
*eg: needles, scalpels, broken glass, razors...*



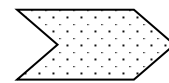
**Biohazardous Sharps**



- ▶ Sharps contaminated with blood or body fluids  
*eg: needles, scalpels, broken glass, razors...*
- ▶ Used sharps contaminated with vaccines



**Regular Waste**



**Any other waste that is not contaminated with any hazardous material such as blood, body fluids, cytotoxins...**  
*eg: non contaminated paper towels, bench paper...*
