## **DR. GHASSAN ABU-SITTAH**

Guest Speaker

---

Dr. Ghassan Abu-Sittah is a British-Palestinian Associate Professor of Surgery and a Plastic & Reconstructive Surgeon. He completed his medical education at University of Glasgow in the U.K and his postgraduate residency training in London.

In 2011 he was recruited by the American University of Beirut Medical Center. In 2012, he became Head of the Division of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery and Clinical Lead of its Pediatric War injuries program and War Injuries Multidisciplinary Clinic. In 2015, he co-founded and became director of the Conflict Medicine Program at Global Health Institute at the American University of Beirut.

He is an Honorary Senior Clinical Lecturer at the Center for Blast Injury Studies at Imperial College University of London and Visiting Senior Lecturer at the Conflict & Health Research Group at Kings College London University. He is Clinical Lead for the Operational Trauma Initiative at the World Health Organization's EMRO Office and served on the board of directors of INARA and Board of Trustees of the UK based Medical Aid for Palestinians. He serves on the UK's National Institute of Health Research (NIHR) International Funding Committee.

He has published extensively on the health consequences of prolonged conflict and on war injuries. He has worked as a war surgeon in Yemen, Iraq, Syria, South Lebanon and during the 4 wars in the Gaza Strip.

On the 9th of October 2023 he entered the Gaza Strip and worked in Shifa Hospital and then Al-Ahli-Baptist Hospital for 43 days during the current war. In April 2024 he was elected Lord Rector of University of Glasgow.
