DR. HUDA ZURAYKGuest Speaker

Huda Zurayk is an Emeritus Professor at the Faculty of Health Sciences of the American University of Beirut since 2017. She was Dean of the Faculty of Health Sciences from 1998 to 2008, where she propelled advancement of graduate teaching, strengthening of group funded research, attention to practice activities, and development of administrative services, all culminating in accreditation of the Faculty of Health Sciences by the US Council on Education for Public Health (CEPH) in 2006. Before that, she spent ten years in Cairo from 1987 to 1998 serving as Senior Associate in the Population Council's regional office, where she participated in its multidisciplinary regional research awards (MEAwards) and other programs.

She also established in 1988 the multidisciplinary regional Reproductive Health Working Group (RHWG) that is still active to date, focusing on knowledge production and policy advocacy for women's health within the region's social context, and contributing critically to global concerns.

Dr. Zurayk undertook her graduate studies at AUB earning a BA in Statistics in 1965. She earned an MA in Statistics in 1966 from Harvard University, and a PhD in Biostatistics in 1974 from the Johns Hopkins University School of Public Health with an added focus on Population Studies. She joined the Faculty of Health Sciences as Assistant Professor in the Department of Epidemiology and Biostatistics in 1974. When she left AUB in 1987 to join the Population Council, she had already earned the rank of Professor, returning to AUB in 1998.
