The purpose of the College Outcomes Survey is to assess student outcomes related to career, emotional, intellectual, moral, physical, and social development, as well as to assess satisfaction with the institution they attend.

The College Outcomes Survey consists of five sections (multiple-choice format): (1) background information, (2) college outcomes, (3) satisfaction with various aspects of the institution, (4) additional questions, and (5) a comments and suggestions section designed to elicit written feedback. This instrument is generally administered to students as they are completing their course of study.
