THE CASE OF BATROUN



VULNERABILITY

Is the degree to which a system is susceptible to, and unable to cope with, adverse effects of climate change, including climate variability and extremes.



EXPOSURE

Refers to the character, magnitude, and rate of change and variation in the climate.



SENSITIVITY

Determines the degree to which a system is adversely or beneficially affected by a given climate change exposure.



ADAPTIVE CAPACITY

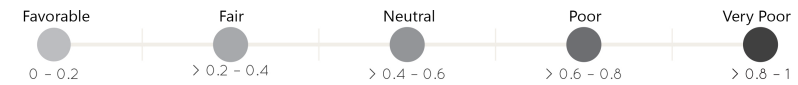
Refers to 'the ability of a system to adjust to climate change (including climate variability and extremes) to moderate potential damages, to take advantage of opportunities, or to cope with the consequences'.

COLOR-CODING USED IN THE IMPACT CHAINS

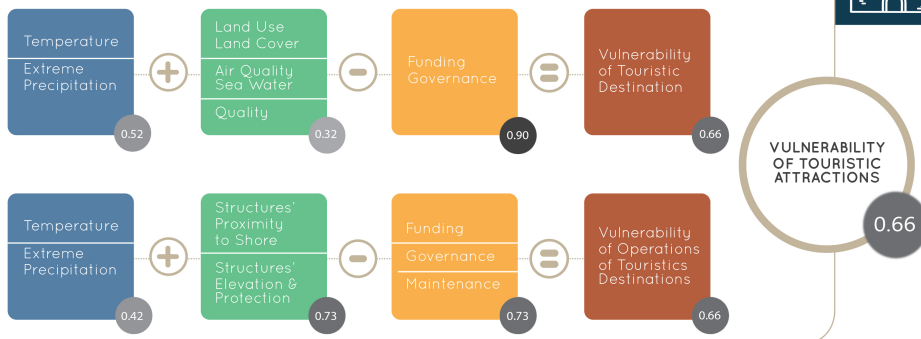

VULNERABILITY SCORE

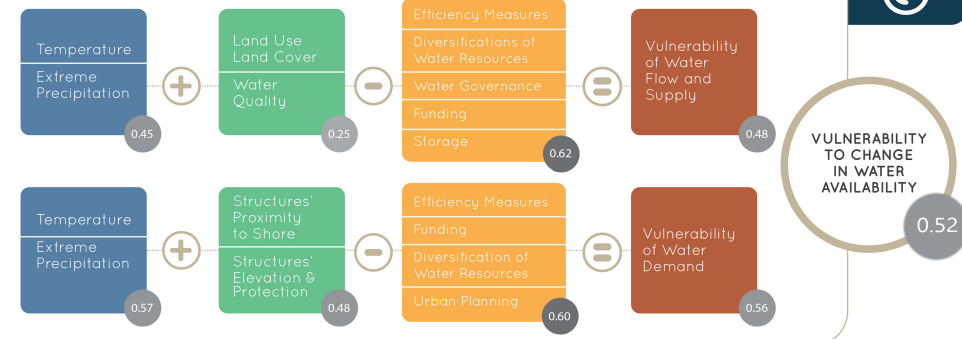
Value within range 0 to 1



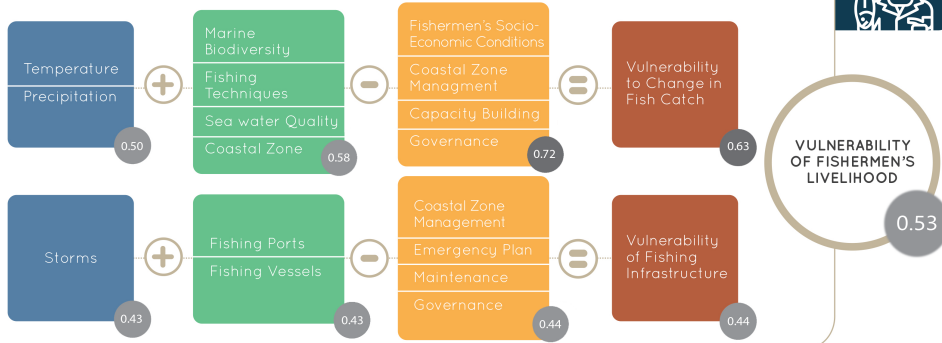
